## 2013-14 CBA Changes

An open forum meeting was held at Cedarvale Lanes this spring. This meeting was open to all CBA members to attend. The focus of the meeting was to discuss any rule/format changes and to try to gain some insight into how to increase entries without decreasing integrity. The following are changes that were approved and will go into effect immediately (1<sup>st</sup> tournament of the 2013-14 season).

1. Entry fee reduced from \$90 to \$75.
2. Optional Qualifying entry reduced from \$30 to \$25
3. Membership fee reduced from \$50 yearly to \$25 yearly. The \$10 non-member fee remained unchanged.

One of the reasons we were able to reduce fees is due to some increased sponsorship monies. We felt that we could keep a very similar prize fund while decreasing the monthly cost to the membership body. If this attempted reduction in costs is unsuccessful, we will certainly re-visit this at next year's open forum meeting.

Please remember that this is YOUR organization. We need the input from you, the competitors, at these yearly meetings. Your attendance and opinions are very important to the success of the organization.

## Kreyer Wins Inaugural CBA Masters Qualifier for his 3<sup>rd</sup> Title of the Season

33 bowlers competed in the first ever CBA Masters Qualifier. Since the US Open was cancelled, we chose to turn our normal December qualifier into a Masters Qualifier instead. Thank you to the Minnesota Bowling Proprietors for their generous sponsorship, agreeing to pay for an entry into the USBC Masters on behalf of the Champion. The scoring pace was fairly high, and it took an average of 213.6 to cash and 214.9 to make the cut to match play. Day 2 brought the top 10 back for round robin match play. At the end of match play, the top 5 heading into the step ladder finals were: 5<sup>th</sup>, Scott Anderson; 4<sup>th</sup>, Chad Nelson; 3<sup>rd</sup>, Dan Bock; 2<sup>nd</sup>, Clark Poelzer and 1<sup>st</sup> seed John Kreyer, Jr. Match 1 had Scott Anderson taking on Chad Nelson. An open in the 4<sup>th</sup> for Anderson, and a clean game with a 6 bagger in the middle for Nelson left Nelson advancing to face Dan Bock, 248-211. Nelson's look on the lanes continued as he started with the front 4, spare, turkey. Bock uncharacteristically chopped the 6-10 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> frame and after staging a little comeback, left the 7-10 in the 10<sup>th</sup> to open the way for Chad to advance 243-202 and move on to face "The Bowler of the Decades", Clark Poelzer. Clark missed the baby split in the 1<sup>st</sup>, but had the favor repaid when Chad left the 7-10 in the 5<sup>th</sup>. Chad struggled for a look, but never really found one, while Clark was able to string a 4 bagger in the middle and held on at the end, staying clean after the 1<sup>st</sup>, to edge out Chad 212-202 and advance into the title match against Kreyer. John missed a 4 pin in frame 1 while Clark went spare, spare, 4 bagger and looked to be cruising. John found a good look in the 6<sup>th</sup>, and struck through the 9<sup>th</sup> to close the gap. Clark left a costly 6-7-10 in the 7<sup>th</sup>, leaving the match within 4 pins in the 8<sup>th</sup> frame. Disaster for Clark struck in the 10<sup>th</sup>, when he left a greek church on his first ball, allowing Kreyer to just fill with a 10 pin conversion and then a strike in the 10<sup>th</sup> to win the Masters spot, and his 3<sup>rd</sup> title of the season, 218-196.
