## 2013-14 CBA Changes

An open forum meeting was held at Cedarvale Lanes this spring. This meeting was open to all CBA members to attend. The focus of the meeting was to discuss any rule/format changes and to try to gain some insight into how to increase entries without decreasing integrity. The following are changes that were approved and will go into effect immediately (1<sup>st</sup> tournament of the 2013-14 season).

1. Entry fee reduced from \$90 to \$75.
2. Optional Qualifying entry reduced from \$30 to \$25
3. Membership fee reduced from \$50 yearly to \$25 yearly. The \$10 non-member fee remained unchanged.

One of the reasons we were able to reduce fees is due to some increased sponsorship monies. We felt that we could keep a very similar prize fund while decreasing the monthly cost to the membership body. If this attempted reduction in costs is unsuccessful, we will certainly re-visit this at next year's open forum meeting.

Please remember that this is YOUR organization. We need the input from you, the competitors, at these yearly meetings. Your attendance and opinions are very important to the success of the organization.

## Clark Poelzer wins the Storm CBA at Super Bowl

The bowler of the decades, Clark Poelzer, wins the Storm CBA at Super Bowl in Ramsey, MN., on January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Poor weather and conflicting tournaments led to only 26 entries, meaning only the top 8 would go into the luck of the draw match play, and only 4 bowlers making the step ladder. Dave Mitchell lead qualifying on the demanding pattern at +210. It took a score of +39 to cash and make match play. Sam Sylvester pulled into the lead during the match play and was the #1 seed going into the step ladder matches at +300, with Clark Poelzer pulling out a last frame victory and earning the bonus pins to edge out Charles Hayslett for the 4<sup>th</sup> and final spot of the ladder. Dan Bock and Dave Mitchell filled the ladder up in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place positions respectively. Mitchell's look was certainly starting to go away and 3 opens during the first match against Poelzer made for easy work for Clark as he struck his way to a 244-186 victory. A fairly similar fate would face Dan Bock as he never really could get settled in to a reaction that made him comfortable. Clark had lost a little carry as well, but was able to continue striking enough to edge Dan 216-181, and move onto the finals against Sam Sylvester. Both bowlers found a shape and carry in the finals and started striking. Clark strung the first 5 on Sam before leaving a 4-7 in the 6<sup>th</sup>. Sam was keeping the pressure on by starting with a 10 pin, conversion, followed by a 6 bagger of his own. A 10 pin in the 7<sup>th</sup> stopped his string and left him with a 1 pin lead in the 6<sup>th</sup>. But Clark picked back up where he left off and struck the next 4 shots before a 9 pin, spare, left him with 267 and leaving Sam needing to strike at least the first shot in the 10<sup>th</sup> for a victory. He struck the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>, but fell short leaving a 6 pin on his first shot in the 10<sup>th</sup> handing Clark the victory.
