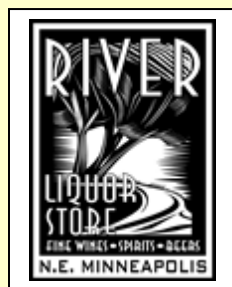
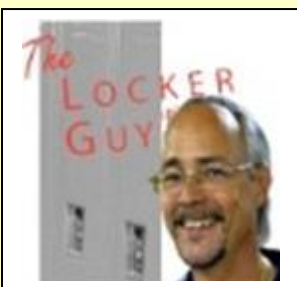
2013-14 CBA Changes

An open forum meeting was held at Cedarvale Lanes this spring. This meeting was open to all CBA members to attend. The focus of the meeting was to discuss any rule/format changes and to try to gain some insight into how to increase entries without decreasing integrity. The following are changes that were approved and will go into effect immediately (1st tournament of the 2013-14 season).

1. Entry fee reduced from \$90 to \$75.
2. Optional Qualifying entry reduced from \$30 to \$25
3. Membership fee reduced from \$50 yearly to \$25 yearly. The \$10 non-member fee remained unchanged.

One of the reasons we were able to reduce fees is due to some increased sponsorship monies. We felt that we could keep a very similar prize fund while decreasing the monthly cost to the membership body. If this attempted reduction in costs is unsuccessful, we will certainly re-visit this at next year's open forum meeting.

Please remember that this is YOUR organization. We need the input from you, the competitors, at these yearly meetings. Your attendance and opinions are very important to the success of the organization.

Kreyer Goes Back to Back, winning the CBA @ Island Xtreme Bowl, Sponsored by Hammer

Congratulations to John Kreyer, Jr., New Brighton, winning back to back tournaments by winning the CBA @ Island Xtremem Bowl, sponsored by Hammer. Chad Nelson was the leading qualifier, averaging just over 252 for the 8 games, at +419. It took a score of +122 to make the cut to match play. With no carry-over of qualifying pins and re-oiling before match play, the WTA pattern Montreal had a cut score for the step ladder of +130. Chad Nelson was that number and took on July's champion, Matt Paine in the first match of the step ladder. A four bagger for Matt, and Chad not being able to get more than a double put Matt Paine moving forward to match 2 of the stepladder, winning 222-195. 3rd place seed Dan Bock showed that he wanted to win title 3 this season by shooting 297, cruising to victory over Matt's 224. Next up for Bock would be #2 seed Dave Langer. Bock continued to strike with Langer pacing him through 4 frames. The match would remain close until Langer left a costly washout in the 9th, giving Bock, who stayed clean in the match, the opportunity to meet Kreyer in the finals, 237-221. Bock stayed clean in the finals as well, converting a couple of difficult spares and striking the last 4 shots. In the end, the 6 bagger that Kreyer had throughout the middle of the match would prove to be enough to hold on for the victory, 246-234.
